The past few years, the international Caravaggesque movement has been the object of several major exhibitions. Whereas an increasing number of monographic studies have been conducted recently on artists from the Southern Netherlands related to this movement, a comprehensive study on the specificity, the impact, reception and diffusion of Caravaggio's pictorial innovations in the Spanish Netherlands and the Princely Diocese of Liège, is still lacking. Surely, this lacuna is due in part to the complex, elusive and disrupted history of Flemish Caravaggism, discouraging any attempt to grasp its character.

Therefore, this international conference intends to review the present state of knowledge on the Caravaggesque movement in the Southern Netherlands with the aim to reach a better understanding of the phenomenon and to open up new lines of inquiry for further research on the topic.
